Acceptable Use Policy for Computer Users
K-6

Unless directed by a teacher...

1. Students may use the computers in the District only with direct staff supervision.
2. Students must go to educationally appropriate sites only.
3. Personal account information may not be given to classmates nor should personal information be given on-line.
4. Students will be held responsible for any damage to hardware, software or data on the computers.
5. Downloading any programs from the Internet is prohibited.
6. Students should use only their student account to access computers provided they have been given one by their teacher.
7. Unless part of an educational assignment, sending, and receiving email is not allowed.
8. Students must not copy any other student's work.
9. School rules regarding the use of appropriate language towards staff and students apply to computer use.

The District reserves the right to restrict or deny access to its technological resources to those users who do not comply with its policies. Violations of this policy may also subject the user to appropriate disciplinary penalties. All accounts and files on the District network are considered to be public domain. System administrators (both faculty and administrators) have access to these accounts and will monitor them.
