The Liberty Bell High School Honors Diploma was created to recognize sustained academic achievement by students who have consistently challenged themselves, and to encourage students to take full advantage of the rich offerings at Liberty Bell High School. In order to graduate with an Honors Diploma, students must:

- maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA
- complete an academic career that has been honorable and free of cheating and plagiarism
- maintain a consistent attendance record: be free of excessive absences and tardies
- successfully complete a total of twelve *year-long classes* from the three categories below:

- Receiving an Honors diploma is a requirement to become the valedictorian or salutatorian.
